LECTIONARY 4 (YEAR A)

What does the Lord ask of us? To do justice, to love kindness, and to walk humbly with God. These are simple words from today's first reading that, nonetheless, remain a challenge for anyone who recognizes the injustice and suffering that mark and mar much of human existence. In the gospel reading, Jesus teaches his disciples a way of seeing those who are blessed in God's sight: the poor, the mourners, the meek, those who hunger for righteousness, the merciful, the pure in heart, the peacemaker. These are the people to whom Jesus has constant recourse in his ministry. How does this congregation serve them?
